

Pacific Valve ITUNES Help

Playing ITUNES Music on CyberServer

We suggest that you drag and drop your playlist directly onto the CyberServer SSD.

1. On Windows, Navigate to the "Network" folder.
2. Look for the "DIGITALENTERNA" directory
3. Navigate into the "media" directory
4. Create a folder inside the directory. It is suggested that it is the same name as your iTunes playlist.
5. Navigate to the iTunes folder that you want to play on CyberServer
6. Select the songs you want or hit Ctrl-A for all songs.
7. Navigate back to the CyberServer media directory
8. Paste the selected songs. This will start the copy of the songs directly onto CyberServer. CyberServer will play the MP4 format and no other conversion is necessary.
9. Note: Files that were purchased using iTunes DRM will not play on CyberServer. You must first remove the iTunes DRM (it will cost you) by accessing the iTunes store and selecting this option. For more information on the current state of DRM, refer to iTunes help.

Moving Music from CyberServer to ITUNES

Any music that is on CyberServer can be moved to iTunes. However, ITUNES does not yet support the audiophile grade FLAC format (it may in the future). Because of this, you must convert your CyberServer FLAC files back to WAV files and then place them on CyberServer. You can use MediaMonkey to convert FLAC files to WAV files, then drag and drop these files onto your ITUNES library.

1. Open MediaMonkey. On the left hand side you will see a file folder music pane. Navigate to your Comprehensive Music Library.
2. Navigate to the folder you want on ITUNES
3. Drag and drop that folder onto MediaMonkey
4. Choose "Edit" and then "Select All"
5. Select "Tools" and then "Convert Audio Format"
6. Choose your destination directory outside of your "Comprehensive Music Library" folder.
7. On the right hand side, under format, choose "WAV"
8. Then hit "OK"
9. You can now "Drag and Drop" songs onto ITUNES.
